

# West Virginia State of the Arts Survey



The West Virginia State of the Arts Survey enables community leaders to identify arts education strengths and deficiencies in West Virginia's K-12 public schools in order to celebrate strengths and to take steps toward improvement. Prior to this survey, no comprehensive scientific data existed to measure how West Virginia's public schools are performing in music, drama, visual art or dance.

This comprehensive survey amassed quantitative and qualitative information about the breadth and depth of arts education programs and curriculum in each of West Virginia's fifty-five counties. It determined, for example, how many minutes per week the average

child at each grade level participates in each arts discipline, the extent to which artists-in-residence are employed in the classroom, whether there are classrooms dedicated to each of the arts, and other relevant information. The survey also gathered information about the qualifications of existing arts teachers, particularly whether or not they are certified in the discipline they teach and the extent to which they participate in professional development in the arts.

The results of the West Virginia State of the Arts Survey have been compiled into a report that will be shared with education, legislative and arts leaders throughout the state. This survey presents a unique opportunity to thoroughly document the strengths and challenges of arts education curricula across the state. In general, this baseline profile will assist AEI, state agencies and independent arts education organizations to more effectively target advocacy and program intervention where it is needed the most. Specifically, the findings from this research will enable AEI and other arts organizations to develop grassroots programs relevant to specific counties and communities. It will also reveal to prospective funders that there is a need for supplemental funding for arts education programming in West Virginia.

In short, AEI will use the results of the West Virginia State of the Arts Survey in the following ways:

- To serve as a needs analysis to guide AEI, state agencies, independent arts education organizations and others' programming to serve the greatest need
- improvement; AEI's goal is to conduct the Survey again in three years in order to assess improvement in arts education
- Share the information revealed by the West Virginia State of the Arts Survey with education,


#### Methodology

The survey instrument was developed and tested by the Ohio Alliance for Arts Education, It consists of 112 multiple choice questions, and has been statistically analyzed for reliability and validity. AEI does not guarantee the accuracy of the survey results, as the information is based on the feedback of one or a few county school personnel.

AEI has determined the following information for each county: the percentage of students being taught music, visual arts, theater and dance by an arts specialist; the number of minutes per week the average student receives arts instruction at each grade level; the types of music, visual arts, theater and dance programs, clubs and organizations available for students at each grade level; the arts education professional development opportunities available to general classroom teachers and arts specialists; the availability of afterschool, summer and other extracurricular and private arts programming; and the funding sources of arts programs, arts teachers and professional development, both including, and in addition to, the state budget.

The information contained in the survey was received by conducting face-to-face or telephone interviews with the county arts contacts in each of West Virginia's 55 counties. The arts contact is designated by the WW Department of Education and is the person who is responsible for distributing relevant information to teachers of all arts content areas. Each year, Julia Lee, Fine Arts Coordinator for the Department of Education, sends out a questionnaire to contacts in each county in order to assure that this position is filled. These contacts consist of either the Assistant Superintendent, Director of Curriculum and Instruction, Curriculum Supervisor, Administrative Assistant, Director of Specific Programs, Associate Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction, Superintendent, Director of Vocational Education, Director of Elementary Education, Director of Secondary Schools, Art Curriculum Specialist, Director of Instruction, Deputy Director, Arts Supervisor, Fine Arts Coordinator, Staff Development Supervisor, Supervisor of Humanities, Art Teacher, Drama/Fine Arts Chairperson, or County Office Director. The arts contact has either chosen this responsibility or is assigned the position. AEI interviewed this group of people because information regarding arts curriculum and arts activities coming directly from the state department of education passes through their hands, giving them insight and access to the status of arts education in their county.

#### Methodology

If a face-to-face or telephone interview could not be set up with the arts contact, AEI arranged to mail or e-mail the survey in order for the arts contact to complete and return the survey to AEI.


Each interview began by informing the arts contact of AEI's presence or desired presence in his or her county, explaining AEI's mission, and providing the arts contact with general information about AEI. The questions on the survey were then asked and recorded by the AEI's Director of Programs, Melanie Roberson. Questions were asked exactly as they appeared on the survey questionnaire so as to preserve the survey's validity.

After AEI received each county's completed survey, the information was then given to West Virginia University's Survey Research Center, the statistician for the West Virginia State of the Arts Survey, for professional data analysis. The survey is broken into two parts:




- 1. West Virginia's over-all state analysis of arts education
- 2. West Virginia County Profiles: each county's response to specific arts education questions

In the short-term, this data will provide a comprehensive look at arts education in every county, thereby strengthening the statement of need for supplemental funding for arts education. The long-term results of the survey's findings will serve as a needs assessment and will assist AEI, other education agencies and county administrators in seeking systemic ways through long-term planning and allocation of resources to make the arts a meaningful part of the life of every child in West Virginia. Where the arts are struggling, county superintendents must be encouraged to seek creative ways to accomodate a strong core curriculum while maintaining quality arts instruction. The West Virginia State of the Arts Survey will also be a catalyst to coalesce AEI, state agencies, legislators, parents and school administrators in developing a cohesive advocacy network for arts education.




#### I. Is your school county a:

About 47% of school counties are rural, about 38% are urban, and almost 15% are suburban. (Information was derived from the U.S. Census Bureau, 2002 Economic Census.)




#### 3. From which of the following groups in your county does encouragement for the arts come?

Almost 93% of arts teachers and almost 55% of other teachers provide encouragement for the arts. Almost 64% of respondents perceived that the community provides support for the arts.




#### 2. What is your county's student enrollment?

In the 2004-2005 school year, about 73% of all counties in West Virginia had more than 2,000 students enrolled. Only about 2% (one county) had less than 1,000 students. About one-fourth of the counties had at least 1,000 but less than 2.000 students.




#### 4. Does your community have an exemplary/ innovative arts program currently in operation in any of the following levels?

Sixty percent of respondents said their counties have an exemplary/innovative arts program for grades 9-12, whereas almost one-third said they have an exemplary/innovative program for grades K-3.




#### 5. If there is an exemplary program, what makes that program special?

Of those schools that have exemplary programs, about 56% of respondents said that arts teachers make their programs special. Use of technology was selected by about 9%, and artists-in-residence were seen as contributing by about 18% of respondents.




#### 6. Other than funding, please select the most critical needs in your county for arts education.

Almost 42% said sufficient scheduling time is a critical need. About 47% said materials and supplies are critical needs, and about 36% said adequate facilities are critical needs.




#### 7. Which of the following documents are reflected in your course of study for dance, drama/theatre, music, and visual art?

All respondents said that West Virginia Content Standards and Objectives are reflected in their course of study, and about 36% said that the National Standards for Arts Education are also reflected in their course of study.




#### 9. How many of your schools have a Music room that is equipped and assigned primarily for music instruction?

One-fifth of respondents said that all schools in their county have a Music room that is equipped and assigned primarily for instruction in Music, and about 47% said most schools have a Music room. No respondents said that no schools in their county have a Music room.




#### 8. How many of your schools have a Visual Arts room that is equipped and assigned primarily for instruction in visual arts?

Only about 9% of respondents said that all schools in their county have a Visual Arts room equipped and assigned primarily for instruction in the Visual Arts. About 44% said most schools have a Visual Arts room, and about 46% said some schools have a Visual Arts room.




#### 10. How many of your schools have a Drama/ Theatre room that is equipped and assigned primarily for drama/theatre instruction?

About 58% of respondents said that some schools in their county have a Drama/Theatre room that is equipped and assigned primarily for Drama/Theatre instruction. About 35% of respondents said no schools in their county have a Drama/Theatre room that is equipped and assigned for Drama/Theatre instruction.




#### II. How many of your schools have a Dance room that is equipped and assigned primarily for Dance instruction?


#### 13. Are field trips taken in your county for arts related subjects?

Almost 95% of respondents said that students take arts related field trips in their county.




#### 12. Do students take educational field trips in your county?

Almost 73% of respondents said that their county does have a countywide, special, annual event(s) to celebrate their arts education programs within their community.




#### 15. How is student achievement in the Visual Arts measured in your county? (You may choose more than one.)

About 96% of respondents said that Teacher Observation is used to measure student achievement in the Visual Arts, and about 78% said Performance/portfolio is used to measure student achievement. Almost 46% of respondents said Competition Ratings are used to measure student achievement.


#### 16. How is student achievement in Music measured in your county? (You may choose more than one.)

Almost 95% of respondents said that Teacher Observation is used to measure student achievement in Music. Almost 75% of respondents said student achievement is measured by Competition Ratings, and almost 66% said student achievement is measured by Performance/portfolio.




#### 17. How is student achievement in Drama/ Theatre measured in your county? (You may choose more than one.)

Almost 91% of respondents said Teacher Observation is used to measure student achievement in Drama/Theatre. Almost 53% of respondents said that student achievement is measured by Performance/portfolio, and 40% said student achievement is measured by Competition Ratings.




#### 19. Which one of the following does your county require for graduation from high school?

Almost 84% of respondents said their county requires one arts class to graduate from high school, and almost 11% of respondents said their county requires more than one arts class.




#### 18. How is student achievement in Dance measured in your county? (You may choose more than one.)


#### 20. Are arts grades used in determining student eligibility for the honor roll in your county?

Almost 84% of respondents said arts grades are used in determining student eligibility for the honor roll in their county.




#### 21. Do the arts teachers have placement decisions for the following students who are mainstreamed into arts classes?

About 49% of the respondents said that arts teachers have placement decisions for handicapped students, and almost 42% of respondents said arts teachers have placement decisions for gifted students. About 38% of respondents said that arts teachers have placement decisions for at-risk students.




#### 23. Which Visual Arts program had an artist in residence during the last three years?

About a guarter of respondents said that Grades K-3 (25.5%) and Grades 4-6 (23.6%) had artists in residence in their counties during the last three years. However, the data suggests that over two-thirds (67.3%) of the Visual Arts programs do not have artist in residence programs.




#### 22. Which of the following services are provided for students identified as gifted in the visual and performing arts? (You may choose more than one.)

Almost 33% of respondents said that a Pull-out program is a service provided for students identified as gifted in the visual and performing arts. About 27% of respondents said individualized instruction is provided, and almost 26% of respondents said classroom grouping is provided.




#### 24. Which Music program had an artist in residence during the last three years?

Twenty percent of respondents said that Grades K-3 had artists in residence in their counties during the last three years. Almost 22% of respondents said that Grades 7-8 had artists in residence, and almost 24% of respondents said Grades 4-6 had artists in residence in their counties during the last three years.




#### 25. Which Drama/Theatre program had an artist in residence during the last three years?

About 16% of respondents said that Grades K-3 and 4-6 had a Drama/Theatre artist in residence in their counties during the last three years. The data suggests that about 78% of the counties do not have artist in residence programs for Drama/Theatre.




#### 27. Which Visual Arts programs have extracurricular activities available?

Almost 42% of the respondents said that Grades 9-12 have extra-curricular activities available in the Visual Arts, and almost 22% said that Grades K-3 have extra-curricular activities available. The data suggests that about 53% of the counties do not have extra-curricular activities for the Visual Arts.




#### 26. Which Dance program had an artist in residence during the last three years?

Almost 15% of respondents said that their counties had a Dance artist in residence for Grades 9-12 during the last three years. However, the data suggests that 86% of the counties do not have artist in residence programs for Dance.




#### 28. Which Music programs have extracurricular activities available?


#### 29. Which Drama/Theatre programs have extracurricular activities available?





#### 31. If you have extra-curricular Visual Arts programs, are they conducted by:

#### 32. If you have extra-curricular Music programs, are they conducted by:


Almost 75% of respondents said their counties' extracurricular Music programs are conducted by certificated/ licensed employees with a supplemental contract. About 27% of respondents said their extra-curricular Music programs are conducted by certificated/licensed employees without a supplemental contract.






#### 33. If you have extra-curricular Drama/Theatre education programs, are they conducted by:

Almost 33% of respondents said that their counties' extracurricular Drama/Theatre programs are conducted by certificated/licensed employees without a supplemental contract. 
#### 34. If you have extra-curricular Dance education programs, are they conducted by:


#### 35. Are there regularly scheduled countywide arts faculty meetings where lessons, materials, and programs are discussed, articulated, developed, and/or evaluated?


#### 37. How many arts supervisors are there at the county level?

About 62% of respondents said that there are no arts supervisors at the county level. About 32% said that there is one arts supervisor at the county level.




#### 36. How frequently are the countywide arts faculty meetings held?

Almost 11% of respondents said countywide arts faculty meetings are held quarterly or once a semester.




#### 38. If you have countywide supervisors, for which arts are these supervisors responsible?


#### 39. For whom are Visual Arts professional development/in-service workshops provided by the county at least once a year?


#### 41. For whom are Drama/Theatre professional development/in-service workshops provided by the county at least once a year?


#### 40. For whom are Music professional development/in-service workshops provided by the county at least once a year?


#### 42. For whom are Dance professional development /in-service workshops provided by the county at least once a year?


#### 43. In your county, which agencies and/or personnel generally conduct professional development/in-service offerings in Arts **Education?**






#### 47. How many minutes per week does your county normally provide for each K-3 Music student?


#### 46. How many minutes per week does your county normally provide for each K-3 Visual Arts student?


#### 48. How many minutes per week does your county normally provide for each K-3 Drama/ Theatre student?


#### 49. How many minutes does your county normally provide for each K-3 Dance student?

Almost 84% of respondents said their counties normally do not provide any time for K-3 Dance students.




#### 51. What percentage of these minutes for each K-3 Music student are taught by a certificated/ licensed Music specialist?

Almost 86% of respondents said that 81 to 100% of the minutes for each K-3 Music student are taught by a certificated/licensed Music specialist.




#### 50. What percentage of these minutes for each K-3 Visual Arts student are taught by a certificated/licensed Visual Arts specialist?








#### 54. How many minutes per week does your county normally provide for each 4-6 Visual Arts student?


#### 56. How many minutes per week does your county normally provide for each 4-6 Drama/ Theatre student?




#### 59. What percentage of these minutes for each 4-6 Music student are taught by a certificated/ licensed Music specialist?

Almost 93% of the respondents said that 81-100% of the minutes for each 4-6 Music student are taught by a certificated/licensed Music specialist.




#### 58. What percentage of these minutes for each 4-6 Visual Arts student are taught by a certificated/licensed Visual Arts specialist?

About 67% of the respondents said that 81-100% of the minutes for each 4-6 Visual Arts student are taught by a certificated/licensed Visual Arts specialist.




#### 60. What percentage of these minutes for each 4-6 Drama/Theatre student are taught by a certificated/licensed Drama/Theatre specialist?

About 9% of the respondents said that 1-20% of the minutes for each Drama/Theatre student are taught by a certificated/ licensed Drama/Theatre specialist.








#### 62. How many minutes per week does your county normally provide for each 7-8 Visual Arts specialist?


#### 64. How many minutes per week does your county normally provide for each 7-8 Drama/ Theatre student?

About 78% of the respondents said that their counties do not provide Drama/Theatre instruction for Grades 7-8.




#### 65. How many minutes per week does your county normally provide for each 7-8 Dance student?

Almost 82% of the respondents said that their counties do not provide Dance instruction for Grades 7-8.




#### 66. What percentage of these minutes for each 7-8 Visual Arts student are being taught by a certificated/licensed Visual Arts specialist?

About 96% of the respondents said that 81-100% of the minutes for each 7-8 Visual Arts student are taught by a certificated/licensed Visual Arts specialist.




#### 47. What percentage of these minutes for 7-8 Music student are being taught by a certificated/licensed Music specialist?






#### 70. Which of the arts subjects are taught in the 7th and 8th grades? Visual Arts:

About 98% of the respondents said that Visual Arts subjects are taught in both 7th and 8th grades.




#### 71. Which of the arts subjects are taught in the 7th and 8th grades? Music:

About 98% of the respondents said that Music subjects are taught in both 7th and 8th grades.




#### 72. Which of the arts subjects are taught in the 7th and 8th grades? Drama/Theatre:































































The West Virginia State of the Arts Survey was completed by the following groups of people: curriculum administrators (34.5%), county-level administrators (23.6%), assistant superintendents (21.8%), arts education teachers (18.2%), and superintendents (1.8%).

#### **ARTS NEEDS**

When the respondents were asked to select the most critical needs in West Virginia arts education programs, the top three responses were: a lack of materials and supplies, insufficient scheduling time, and inadequate facilities.

#### ARTS-DESIGNATED CLASSROOMS

The existence of arts-designated classrooms varies greatly depending on the art form. Twenty percent of respondents indicated that all schools in their counties have a Music classroom that is equipped and assigned primarily for instruction in Music. Only 9.1% of respondents said that all schools in their counties have a Visual Art classroom equipped and assigned primarily for instruction in the Visual Arts. There are a high percentage of counties, 34.5%, that have no schools with classrooms that are equipped and assigned primarily for Drama/Theater instruction. In fact, only 7.3% of the respondents indicated that most schools have classrooms assigned for Drama instruction. Classrooms equipped and designed specifically for Dance instruction are almost completely lacking in West Virginia schools. 76.4% of respondents indicated that no schools are equipped and assigned for Dance instruction, and only 1.8% of respondents indicated that there are dance rooms in most schools in their counties.

#### ARTIST-IN-RESIDENCY PROGRAMS

The survey data suggests that there is a need for high quality, statewide artist-in-residence programs in West Virginia's public schools. While some respondents indicate that they have received artists-in-residence in Visual Art during the last three years, over two-thirds (67.3%) of the Visual Art programs do not have current artist-in-residence programs. The percentage of Music programs that do not have a current artist-in-residence program is 72.7%. Additionally, 78.2% of the counties do not have a current artist-in-residence program for Drama/Theater. An extremely high percentage of Dance programs, 85.5%, do not have a current artist-in-residence program.

#### **EXTRACURRICULAR ARTS ACTIVITIES**

Music and Drama/Theater are the most popular extracurricular arts activities. A whopping 96.4% of respondents indicated that grades 9-12 have extracurricular Music programs. 78.2% of grades 7-8 offer extracurricular Music programs. The percentages decrease in grades K-3 and grades 4-6. 74.5% of respondents said that their counties' extracurricular Music programs are conducted by arts certificated/licensed employees with a supplemental contract.

Similarly, 78.2% of respondents said that grades 9-12 have extracurricular activities in Drama/Theater. The percentage greatly decreases in grades K-3, grades 4-6 and grades 7-8. The counties that offer extracurricular activities in Drama/Theater indicate that only 40% of the activities are conducted by arts certificated/licensed employees with a supplemental contact.

West Virginia is lacking in extracurricular activities in Visual Art and Dance. The data suggests that 52.7% of counties do not have extracurricular activities available in Visual Arts. Of the counties that do, only 29% said that the programs are conducted by arts certificated/licensed employees with a supplemental contract. Further, 52.7% of counties do not have extracurricular activities available in Dance. Of the counties that do, only 12.7% of respondents indicated that those programs are being conducted by arts certificated/licensed employees with a supplemental contact.

#### ARTS INSTRUCTION IN GRADES K - 3

Not all K-3 Visual Art, Music, Drama/Theater, and Dance instruction is being taught by arts certificated/ licensed employees. In fact, a large percentage of arts instruction is not being taught by arts specialists. For example, most K-3 students in West Virginia are not receiving Drama/Theater or Dance instruction. Of the small percentage that are, they are usually instructed by non-arts-certificated employees. In the Visual Arts, 58.2% of respondents indicated that 81% to 100% of in-school K-3 instruction is given by an arts certificated/licensed employee. It is encouraging, however, to see that most K-3 students are receiving Music instruction from a Music education specialist. 85.5% of respondents indicated that 81% to 100% of in-school K-3 Music instruction is taught by an arts certificated/licensed employee.

78.2% of students in grades K-3 receive 0 minutes of Drama/Theater instruction per week. Of the low percentage of students that do receive Drama/Theater instruction, 11.1% of respondents said that only 1% to 20% of these instructional minutes are taught by Theater education specialists. A slightly higher 83.6% of respondents indicated that K-3 students receive 0 minutes of Dance instruction per week. Of the low percentage of students that do receive Dance instruction, 12.7% of respondents said that only 1% to 20% of these instructional minutes are taught by Dance education specialists.

#### ARTS INSTRUCTION IN GRADES 4 - 6

Again, not all Visual Art, Music, Drama/Theater, and Dance instruction in grades 4 through 6 is being given by arts certificated/licensed employees. Most 4th through 6th grade students are not receiving Drama/Theater and Dance instruction. Of the small percentage of students receiving Drama/Theater and Dance, they are generally instructed by non-arts-certificated teachers. 67.3% of respondents said that 81% to 100% of in-school Visual Art instruction in grades 4 through 6 is given by a certificated/ licensed Visual Art specialist. 92.7% of the respondents said that 81% to 100% of in-school Music instruction in grades 4 through 6 is taught by a certificated/licensed Music specialist. It is an important and extremely positive finding that most West Virginia public schools students are receiving Music instruction by a certificated/licensed Music specialist.

85.5% of respondents indicated that students in grades 4-6 receive 0 minutes of Drama/Theater instruction per week. Of the low percentage of students who do receive Drama/Theater instruction, 9.1% of respondents indicated that only 1% to 20% are taught by Theater specialists. 83.6% of respondents indicated that students in grades 4-6 receive 0 minutes of Dance instruction per week. Of the low

percentage of students who do receive Dance instruction, 12.7% of respondents indicated that only 1% to 20% of instructional minutes are given by Dance specialists.

#### ARTS INSTRUCTION IN GRADES 7 - 8

A very high percentage of 7th and 8th grade Visual Art and Music students receive instruction from arts certificated/licensed specialists. Specifically, 96.4% of the respondents reported that 81% to 100% of Visual Art students in grades 7 and 8 are taught by certificated/licensed Visual Art specialists. 98.2% of the respondents said that 81% to 100% of Music students in grades 7 and 8 receive Music instruction by a Music specialist. Unfortunately, 78.2% of respondents indicated that students in grades 7 and 8 receive 0 minutes of Drama/Theater instruction per week. Of the low percentage of students who do receive Drama/Theater instruction, 3.6% of the respondents indicated that 81% to 100% of the instructional minutes are given by arts certificated/licensed employees. Further, 81.2% of the respondents indicated that students in grades 7 and 8 receive 0 minutes of Dance instruction per week. For the low percentage of students who do, only 1.8% of respondents indicated that 81% -100% of instruction is by Dance specialists. The 7th and 8th grade students who receive Drama/Theater and Dance instruction are largely being taught by non-arts-certificated employees.

#### **ARTS INSTRUCTION IN GRADES 9 - 12**

It is no surprise that there are more Visual Art and Music classes available to West Virginia students in grades 9 through 12 than Dance and Drama/Theater classes. 56.4% of respondents indicated that their counties offer 4 to 6 classes for their 9th through 12th grade Visual Art students. Similarly, 52.7% of respondents indicated that their counties offer 4 to 6 Music classes for their 9-12 Music students. 67.3% of respondents indicated that their counties offer 1 to 3 Drama classes for their 9th through 12th grade Drama/Theater students. 69.1% of respondents indicated that their counties offer 1 to 3 Dance classes for their 9th through 12th grade Dance Students.

#### **ARTS PRIORITIES**

Overall, the survey data suggests that Music and Visual Art are priorities over Drama/Theater and Dance. While many West Virginia public schools do not offer students consistent Music and Visual Art instruction, these courses are far more available then their Dance and Drama/Theater counterparts. West Virginia is sorely lacking in Dance and Drama/Theater programs, specifically at the elementary level.

When respondents were asked how important Dance is compared to other academic subjects, 63.6% of the respondents said that it is not as important. When asked how important Drama/Theater is when compared to other academic subjects, 56.4% of respondents said that it is not as important. On the other hand, when asked how important Music is when compared to other academic subjects, 63.6% of respondents said that it is as important as other subjects. Similarly, when asked how important Visual Art is when compared to other academic subjects, 60% of respondents said that it is as important as other subjects.

It is encouraging to learn that Visual Art and Music are valued by public school administrators as important academic subjects. It is also important that greater awareness is raised around the benefits of high quality Drama/Theater and Dance instruction to ensure West Virginia students have access to all of the arts.

#### **SUMMARY**

The West Virginia State of the Arts Survey reveals both the strengths and the weaknesses of arts programs in the public schools. The findings should be used as a basis for schools, state agencies and arts education organizations to effectively respond to arts education needs as articulated by public school administrators. Additionally, this information provides public school administrators and policy-makers a profile of each West Virginia county, allowing them to compare the findings by region. As a result of these statistical findings, AEI and others who champion the arts education cause will be better able to make a case for necessary improvement where schools fall short of attaining content standards and objectives.
